**Anna Wierer's** love of music has accompanied her since early childhood. With her expressive playing, technical brilliance and musical sensitivity, she captivates audiences alike as a soloist, chamber musician and orchestral performer.

Her exceptional talent was recognised and nurtured from an early age. Born in Saint Petersburg, she began her first flute lessons at the age of three. Just one year later, she was invited to open a concert of the Saint Petersburg Academic State Symphony Orchestra. At the age of ten, she was awarded a scholarship by the Saint Petersburg Philharmonic Society.

She graduated with distinction in 2005 from the prestigious N. A. Rimsky-Korsakov State Conservatory in Saint Petersburg, where she studied with the flautist Alexandra Vavilina. She continued her artistic training at the Hanns Eisler School of Music in Berlin under Professor Eberhard Grünenthal, completing her studies with a diploma as a concert flautist and orchestral musician.

Anna Wierer also received important artistic inspiration through masterclasses with distinguished flautists and musicians, including Aurèle Nicolet, Moshe Aron Epstein, Davide Formisano, Vukan Milin, Pirmin Grehl, Gudrun Hinze and Jean-Louis Beaumadier.

Among her achievements are First Prize at the International Rimsky-Korsakov Competition in Saint Petersburg, as well as awards at the 5th International Competition in Tolyatti and the 10th International Friedrich Kuhlau Flute Competition.

Her concert career has taken her to international stages in China, Japan, France, Italy, Portugal, Spain and Russia. As a piccolo flute soloist, she has performed with ensembles including the Munich Symphony Orchestra, Chamber of Lights and the Berlin Residence Orchestra. She has also appeared on stage with the internationally acclaimed violinist David Garrett.

Her musical artistry is further documented through CD and video recordings. In 2021, the CD *Tales without Words* was released, followed by *Révélations* in 2023, both published by Brilliant Classics.
